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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPORTS OFFICIALS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designate	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>\$70</u>	6- Assault against a sports official. (1) If a
5	person is	convicted of the offense of:
6	<u>(a)</u>	Assault in the first degree, as provided by section
7		707-710;
8	(b)	Assault in the second degree, as provided by section
9		707-711(a), (b), or (d);
10	(C)	Assault in the third degree, as provided by section
11		707-712;
12	(d)	Terroristic threatening in the first degree, as
13		provided by section 707-716(a), (e), or (f); or
14	(e)	Terroristic threatening in the second degree, as
15		provided by section 707-717; and
16	the victi	m of the offense is a sports official engaged in the
17	lawful di	scharge of the sports official's duties, the court may

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1	order, in the court's discretion, that the defendant, in		
2	addition to any other punishment imposed pursuant to chapter		
3	706, be enjoined from attending any sports event of the type at		
4	which the sports official was engaged in the lawful discharge of		
5	the sports official's duties for a period of up to twelve months		
6	from the date of sentencing for a first offense, and for life		
7	for a second or subsequent offense.		
8	(2) For the purposes of this section:		
9	"Lawful discharge of the sports official's duty" means the		
10	performance of duties of a sports official from the time the		
11	sports official arrives at the venue of a sports event and		
12	ending when the sports official returns to their residence or		
13	business.		
14	"Sports event" means any organized amateur or professional		
15	athletic contest in the State.		
16	"Sports official" means a person at a sports event who		
17	enforces the rules of the event, such as an umpire, referee,		
18	timer, or scorer, or a person who supervises the participants,		
19	such as a coach, regardless of whether the person is paid or		
20	provides their services as an unpaid volunteer."		

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SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
