

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part II, subpart B, to be		
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§30</u>	2A- Hawaiian language teaching; elementary schools.	
5	(a) Each	elementary school shall include the teaching of	
6	Hawaiian language in its curriculum.		
7	(b)	The department shall submit a report to the	
8	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of		
9	each regular session on the status of complying with subsection		
10	(a). Rep	orts shall include:	
11	(1)	The number of elementary schools currently teaching	
12		Hawaiian language and the number of students receiving	
13		Hawaiian language instruction;	
14	(2)	A schedule to implement the teaching of Hawaiian	
15		language at all public elementary schools;	
16	(3)	A summary of the Hawaiian language instruction	
17		curriculum provided to students:

1	(4)	The level of Hawaiian language proficiency students
2		have obtained as a result of the required Hawaiian

4	(5)	Timely submitted commentary from the office of

7		Hawaiian language at elementary schools, if any;

9	(7)	Recommendations and proposed legislation, if any."
