PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish the
operating budget for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
and ending June 30, 2021, for state executive branch programs
under the purview of the house of representatives standing
committee on intrastate commerce.

7 SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the8 context, as used in this Act:

9 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
10 a standing committee of the house of representatives, shall mean
11 the following:

15 "Expending agency" means the executive department, 16 independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other 17 establishment of the state government (other than the

legislature, office of Hawaiian affairs, and judiciary), the
 political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public
 institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which
 is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this
 Act.

6 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
7 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
8 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
9 are followed by letter symbols. These letter symbols, where
10 used, shall have the following meanings:

11 B Special funds

12 T Trust funds

"Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a particular program during a specified period or periods, as denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent positions.

19 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific20 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization

responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
 organization number for the program.

PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS 3 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much 4 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and 5 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or 6 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing 7 specified to the expending agency designated for the fiscal 8 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The 9 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal 10 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the number 11 12 indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in 13 this Act, or as provided by general law.

If any portion of a specific appropriation is held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the extent possible. SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may

13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
