

# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KANEOHE BAY REGIONAL COUNCIL.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 200D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 4 "(a) There is established within the department of land
- 5 and natural resources, for administrative purposes only, the
- 6 Kaneohe Bay regional council [ provided that except for the
- 7 participation on the council of the two representatives from the
- 8 department of land and natural resources as ex officio nonvoting
- 9 members pursuant to subsection (c) and except as provided under
- 10 section 26-35, the]. The department of land and natural
- 11 resources shall [not] provide administrative support to the
- 12 council, including providing staff, drafting, and other support
- 13 at council meetings. The council shall be composed of seven
- 14 voting members appointed by the governor in accordance with
- 15 section 26-34 and ex officio nonvoting members as provided in
- 16 subsection (c). The members shall serve without compensation."
- 17 2. By amending subsection (e) to read:

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1	"(e) The chairperson shall be [ <del>the administrator of the</del>
2	aquatic resources division.] selected by the members pursuant to
3	subsection (c) on an annual and rotating basis."
4	SECTION 2. Section 200D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"\$200D-4 [Annual meeting.] Council meetings. The council
7	shall schedule and conduct a meeting in accordance with chapter
8	92 [in each year of its operation.] quarterly."
9	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
