A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOUSING LOAN AND MORTGAGE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the affordable
- 2 housing crisis continues to be one of the State's most
- 3 significant and challenging social problems and is a critical
- 4 issue for many Hawaii residents.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to assist residents in obtaining
- 6 affordable rental housing by increasing the Hula Mae multifamily
- 7 revenue bond authorization.
- 8 SECTION 2. Act 291, Session Laws of Hawaii 1980, as
- 9 amended by Act 304, Session Laws of Hawaii 1996, as amended by
- 10 Act 185, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended by Acts 231 and
- 11 249, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, as amended by Act 121, Session
- 12 Laws of Hawaii 2008, as amended by Act 138, Session Laws of
- 13 Hawaii 2012, as amended by Act 162, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014,
- 14 as amended by Act 175, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is amended
- 15 by amending section 11 to read as follows:
- 16 "SECTION 11. Issuance of revenue bond; amount authorized.
- 17 Revenue bonds may be issued by the Hawaii housing finance and



- 1 development corporation pursuant to part $III[_{7}]$ of chapter 39
- 2 and subpart A of part III of chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised
- 3 Statutes, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed
- 4 [\$1,500,000,000] \$ at such times and in such amounts
- 5 as the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation deems
- 6 advisable for the purpose of undertaking and maintaining any of
- 7 the housing loan programs under subpart A of part III of chapter
- 8 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to the funding or
- 9 purchasing of eligible project loans."
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2075.
