A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Research by the National Education Association 2 has found that reducing class size provides long-term benefits 3 for students and for society as a whole. Reduced class sizes in 4 lower-income school districts help to increase student 5 achievement and students' test scores, alleviate strain on 6 teachers, and raise college-acceptance rates. Furthermore, 7 research by the Center for Educational Equity discovered that 8 smaller class sizes may attract high-quality teachers, citing 9 successes in Tennessee and Wisconsin schools, and smaller class 10 sizes were then adopted by California and Florida. In 11 Rochester, New York, a reduction in class sizes was implemented 12 over a four-year period to manage the effects on personnel and 13 on the budget.

14 The legislature finds that reduced class sizes will also 15 benefit Hawaii's public-school students and teachers. The 16 purpose of this Act is to require the department of education to 17 implement'a reduction in class sizes over four years.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Reduction in class sizes. (a) Notwithstanding
5	any collective bargaining agreement to the contrary, beginning
6	with the 2020-2021 school year and ending with the 2023-2024
7	school year, the department shall implement a reduction in class
8	sizes in all department schools.
9	(b) Over the period specified in subsection (a):
10	(1) Class sizes in elementary schools shall be reduced to
11	no more than twenty students per class; and
12	(2) Class sizes in middle or intermediate schools and in
13	high schools shall be reduced to no more than twenty-
14	five students per class.
15	(c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to
16	charter schools under chapter 302D; special education programs;
17	or elective classes, such as visual arts, music, drama, and
18	dance."
19	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
