HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES THIRTIETH LEGISLATURE, 2019 STATE OF HAWAII H.B. NO. 1152

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARINE RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's 2 nearshore marine resources are being increasingly impacted by 3 local and global stressors and that existing state management 4 measures may be inadequate to ensure long-term sustainability. 5 On September 1, 2016, at the International Union for 6 Conservation of Nature World Conservation Congress in Hawaii, 7 and as part of the sustainable Hawaii initiative, governor David 8 Ige announced the State's commitment to effectively manage 9 thirty per cent of Hawaii's nearshore waters by 2030. Referred 10 to as the marine 30x30 initiative, this effort aims to balance 11 sustainable use with restoration and conservation to benefit 12 local communities now and in the future. The department of land 13 and natural resources is capitalizing on this initiative to 14 establish new strategic directions in the way it manages the 15 State's nearshore marine resources.

16 Led by the division of aquatic resources, the marine 30x3017 initiative includes strategies to reevaluate and update



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1 statewide fishing regulations and to establish a statewide. 2 network of marine managed areas encompassing thirty per cent of 3 the State's nearshore waters. Successful development and 4 implementation of these strategies hinges on effective public 5 outreach and a fair and transparent stakeholder input process, 6 which includes statewide public hearings and concentrated 7 scoping workshops in communities where marine managed areas are 8 proposed.

9 The purpose of this Act is to provide the department of 10 land and natural resources with the funds necessary to establish 11 one full-time, temporary program specialist V position within 12 the department and to successfully undertake the comprehensive 13 stakeholder engagement process associated with the marine 30x30 14 initiative.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$29,808 or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the 18 sum of \$59,616 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 19 year 2020-2021 for the funding of one full-time (1.0 FTE) 20 temporary program specialist V to support the coordination and



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implementation of the marine 30x30 initiative in ecosystem
protection and restoration.

The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 3 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 4 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$83,900 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the 7 8 sum of \$167,800 or so much thereof as may be necessary for 9 fiscal year 2020-2021 to support the department of land and natural resources' strategic communication and stakeholder 10 11 engagement process associated with the marine 30x30 initiative. 12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 13 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 14 This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
