"Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which 1 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the 2 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations 3 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used, 4 shall have the following meanings: 5 Special funds 6 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific 7 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization 8 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the 9 10 organization number for the program. PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS 11 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much 12 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and 13 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or 14 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing 15 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal 16 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The 17 total expenditures in each fiscal year of the biennium shall not 18 exceed the sums indicated for each fiscal year, except as 19 provided elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law. 20
