### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FREE SPEECH.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The legislature finds that the protection of
2	the right	to free speech, which is guaranteed by the First
3	Amendment	to the United States Constitution, within the
4	universit	y of Hawaii system is a matter of statewide concern.
5	Acco	rdingly, the purpose of this Act is to require:
6	(1)	The university of Hawaii to establish a free speech
7		policy for implementation on each campus throughout
8		the university of Hawaii system;
9	(2)	The policies to include a process for students to
10		report alleged violations of free speech rights;
11	(3)	The policies to be disseminated to any person who is
12		responsible for the discipline or education of
13		enrolled students, and be included in each campus's
14		student handbook, student orientation program, and
15		website; and
16	(4)	The university of Hawaii to submit a report to the
17		legislature summarizing the complaints, if any, filed

1		against each campus alleging violation of First	
2		Amendment rights.	
3	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
4	amended b	y adding a new section to part I to be appropriately	
5	designated and to read as follows:		
6	" <u>§30</u>	4A- Campus free speech; policies; reports. (a)	
7	Each camp	us of the University of Hawaii shall:	
8	(1)	Establish a policy regarding free speech that is	
9		protected by the First Amendment to the United States	
10		Constitution; provided that the policy shall include a	
11		process for a student to report alleged violations of	
12		this right;	
13	(2)	Develop materials on the policies and ensure that the	
14		materials are distributed to any person who is	
15		responsible for the discipline or education of	
16		<pre>enrolled students;</pre>	
17	(3)	Include the policies and materials in the campus's	
18		student handbook and student orientation program; and	
19	(4)	Publish on its website the policies and materials	
20		required by this subsection in a searchable, publicly	
21		accessible, and conspicuous manner.

1	(b)	No later than twenty days prior to the convening of
2	each regu	lar session, the University of Hawaii shall submit a
3	report to	the legislature and the governor that includes:
4	(1)	A summary by campus of all complaints alleging a
5		violation of a person's right to free speech under the
6		First Amendment of the United States Constitution that
7		were filed against the university or an employee of
8		the university acting in the employee's official
9		capacity; and
10	(2)	A summary by campus of all lawsuits initiated against
11		the university, or an employee of the university
12		acting in the employee's official capacity, alleging a
13		violation of a person's right to free speech under the
14		First Amendment of the United States Constitution."
15	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
