A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal or abolish
- 2 various non-general funds and accounts pursuant to the
- 3 recommendations by the auditor in auditor's report no. 18-19 and
- 4 to transfer the unencumbered balances to the general fund.
- 5 SECTION 2. The assistance in managing land fund
- 6 administratively established in 2007 is abolished, and any
- 7 remaining unencumbered balances shall lapse to the general fund.
- 8 SECTION 3. The native resources and fire protection
- 9 program special fund administratively established in 2000 is
- 10 abolished, and any remaining unencumbered balances shall lapse
- 11 to the general fund.
- 12 SECTION 4. The preservation of endangered plants trust
- 13 fund administratively established in 1989 is abolished, and any
- 14 remaining unencumbered balances shall lapse to the general fund.
- 15 SECTION 5. The recreational renaissance state parks
- 16 special fund administratively established in 2010 is abolished,

- 1 and any remaining unencumbered balances shall lapse to the
- 2 general fund.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on December 1, 2050.
