1	SECT	ION 1. Section 432:1-407, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

3	"(a)	Net worth requirements are as follows:
4	(1)	Before issuing a certificate of authority pursuant to
5		section 432:1-301, the commissioner shall require that
6		the mutual benefit society has an initial net worth of
7		\$2,000,000 and the society shall thereafter maintain
8		the minimum net worth required under paragraph (2);
9		and
10	(2)	Every mutual benefit society shall maintain a minimum
11		net worth equal to the greater of:
12		(A) \$2,000,000;
13		(B) Two per cent of annual premium revenues as
14		reported on the most recent annual financial
15		statement filed with the commissioner on the
16		first \$150,000,000 of premium revenues and one

1	per cent of annual premium revenues on the
2	premium revenues in excess of \$150,000,000; or
3	(C) An amount equal to eight per cent of the sum of
4	annual health care expenditures and operating
5	expenses as reported on the most recent financial
6	statement filed with the commissioner.
7	For the purposes of subparagraphs (B) and (C), the
8	annual gross premium revenues and gross annual health
9	care expenditures shall be reduced by the total amount
10	thereof ceded to reinsurers by the mutual benefit
11	society; provided that the reinsurance credit taken
12	complies with sections 431:4A-101 through 431:4A-104
13	and the administrative rules adopted thereunder by the
14	commissioner."
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
