A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§15- Languages of requests; ballots. (a) A request
- 5 made pursuant to section 15-4 for an absentee ballot or for
- 6 permanent absentee voter status may be written in the English or
- 7 Hawaiian language. The chief election officer shall make
- 8 request forms in these languages available to the clerks for
- 9 distribution to registered voters.
- 10 (b) The chief election officer shall ensure that absentee
- 11 ballots in English and Hawaiian are available to absentee
- 12 voters, to the extent necessary to fulfill all requests.
- 13 (c) This section shall not be construed to limit the
- 14 applicability of any other election law relating to
- 15 accommodation of individuals who speak or write languages other
- 16 than English."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2020-2021 for the printing of absentee ballot request forms and
- 6 ballots in English and Hawaiian.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 8 elections for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
