

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FOURTEENTH, FIFTEENTH, AND SIXTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is		
9	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are		
10	unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.		
11	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the		
12	designated expending agencies for the purposes of this Act.		
13	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
