A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT OPERATING BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide funding
for the operations of the department of human resources
development for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and
ending June 30, 2021.

5 SECTION 2. The following sums or so much thereof as may be 6 sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated herein are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may 7 8 be, from the means of financing specified to the department of 9 human resources development for the fiscal biennium beginning 10 July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures 11 and the number of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium 12 shall not exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated 13 for each fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act 14 or as provided by general law.

15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$619,076 or so much



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thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the 1 sum of \$651,330 or so much thereof as may be necessary for 2 fiscal year 2020-2021 for the following expenditures of HRD102 -3 4 workforce attraction, selection, classification, and 5 effectiveness: \$147,464 for fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$139,464 for 6 (1)fiscal year 2020-2021, including one permanent full-7 8 time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position to support the learning management system upgrade; 9 \$43,254 for fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$83,508 for 10 (2) fiscal year 2020-2021, including one permanent full-11 time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position to support the 12 office of collective bargaining in the negotiations of 13 labor contracts; 14 for fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$ for 15 (3) \$ fiscal year 2020-2021, including one permanent full-16 time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position for a chief 17 negotiator for collective bargaining; 18 19 (4) \$95,386 for fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$95,386 for 20 fiscal year 2020-2021, including one permanent full-21 time equivalent (1.0 FTE) interdepartmental transfer
