A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide funding
 for the operations of the Hawaii employer-union health benefits
 trust fund for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and
 ending June 30, 2021.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii
employer-union health benefits trust fund the sum of \$10,451,486
or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020
and the sum of \$862,653 or so much thereof as may be necessary
for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the following:

10 (1) \$9,956,000 in fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$367,167 in
11 fiscal year 2020-2021, including three full-time
12 equivalent (3.0 FTE) temporary positions for a new
13 benefits administration system;

14 (2) \$234,169 in fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$234,169 in
15 fiscal year 2020-2021 for fringe benefit rate
16 increases for non-general funded positions;
