BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302D-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§302D-32 Annual audit or financial review[-]; access to
- 4 records. [Each] (a) The authorizer shall require each charter
- 5 school [shall] to annually complete an independent financial
- 6 audit that complies with the requirements of its [authorizer]
- 7 charter contract and the department and is performed by an
- 8 independent auditor selected and determined by the authorizer;
- 9 provided that the authorizer shall have the discretion to allow
- 10 a financial review in lieu of an independent financial audit.
- 11 (b) Each charter school shall provide access to all of its
- 12 records to its authorizer, the legislature, and other state
- 13 agencies with jurisdiction over charter school funds.
- 14 (c) The authorizer, the legislature, or other state
- 15 agencies with jurisdiction over charter school funds may cause a
- 16 search to be made from any records in the custody of a charter
- 17 school, without payment of any fee.

- 2 records, or any portion thereof, upon the request of its
- 3 authorizer, the legislature, or other state agencies with
- 4 jurisdiction over charter school funds.
- 5 (e) As used in this section, "records" means financial
- 6 accounts, accounting systems, books, files, papers, and
- 7 documents."

- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
