8	SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
9	projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
10	designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.
11	SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
12	improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
13	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
14	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
15	unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.
16	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2099.
