

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§286-47 Certificate of registration; certificate of

4 ownership; containers. Upon the registration of a vehicle, the

5 director of finance shall issue a certificate of registration to

6 the owner and a certificate of ownership to the legal owner, or

7 to a dealer who shall be a person licensed to sell new motor

8 vehicles under chapter 437 [which]. The certificates shall meet

(1) Both the certificate of registration and the certificate of ownership shall contain upon the face thereof, the date issued, the registration number assigned to the owner and to the vehicle, the name and address of the owner and legal owner in typewriting, also [such] the description of the registered vehicle as may be determined by the director of finance. If any of the information subsequently proves to be a

	typographical error, the dealer, as defined in section
	437-1.1, shall notify the director of finance of the
	error by a written certificate stating the reasons for
	and nature of the error and the correction [which]
	that should be made in the certificate of registration
	and the certificate of ownership. Upon receipt of the
	dealer's certificate by the director of finance, the
	certificate of registration and the certificate of
	ownership shall be corrected accordingly so long as
	the correction does not constitute a change of the
	vehicle originally registered. A fee shall be paid to
	the director of finance for each instance of
	correction of the registration records. The fee
	charged for each instance of correction of the
	registration records shall be established by the
	county's legislative body;
(2	) In addition to the requirements provided for in
	paragraph (1) above, the face of the certificate of

17			by licensed car dealerships or repossession
18			companies. These businesses may keep a duplicate

3	(D)	This requirement to carry the certificate of
4		registration with the vehicle shall not apply
5		when [such] the certificate is removed from the
6		vehicle for the purpose of application for
7		renewal, transfer of registration, or to record a
8		change in the registration[-]; and
9	<u>(E)</u>	This shall not apply to chassis used for
10		transporting shipping containers. These
11		businesses may keep a duplicate copy of the
12		certificate of registration within the shipping
13		container chassis for which it is registered, in
14		which case the certificate of registration shall
15		be available for inspection at their principal
16		place of business within the State."
17	SECTION 2	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
18	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
19	begun before i	ts effective date.
20	SECTION 3	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.

Certificate of Registration; Shipping Container Chassis
