Certificate of Registration; Shipping Container Chassis

Description:

Authorizes the owner of a shipping container chassis to keep a duplicate copy of the certificate of registration within the shipping container chassis. Requires the owner of a shipping container chassis to make available the original certificate of registration at its principal place of business in the State. (HB1378 HD1)
