- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§302A-102 Smoking prohibited. (a) All public schools
- 4 within the State, from kindergarten through grade twelve, shall
- 5 prohibit the use of tobacco at public schools or at public
- 6 school functions.
- 7 (b) Any person under the age of twenty-one who violates
- 8 subsection (a) shall be fined \$100. In the case of a person
- 9 under the age of eighteen, the fine may be levied against the
- 10 person's parent or legal guardian. The fine levied pursuant to
- 11 this section shall be in addition to any other applicable fines
- 12 or penalties. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to
- 13 chapter 91 to implement this subsection.
- 14 (c) The fine specified in this section shall not be
- 15 <u>suspended or waived.</u>"
