RELATING TO SMOKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§302A-102 Smoking prohibited. (a) All public schools
- 4 within the State, from kindergarten through grade twelve, shall
- 5 prohibit the use of tobacco at public schools or at public
- 6 school functions.
- 7 (b) Any person over the age of twenty-one who violates
- 8 subsection (a) shall be fined \$100. The fine levied pursuant to
- 9 this section shall be in addition to any other applicable fines
- 10 or penalties. The department shall adopt rules, including non-
- 11 monetary penalties for students, pursuant to chapter 91 to
- 12 implement this subsection.
- (c) The fine specified in this section shall not be
- 14 suspended or waived."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.

- 1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 28, 2081.
