### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE BUSINESS CORPORATIONS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that sustainable business SECTION 1. 2 corporations are for-profit corporations that choose to and are 3 legally obligated to operate under a corporate governance structure that considers whether business decisions and actions 4 5 accomplish a material positive impact on society and the environment. Because of this choice to adhere to a governance 6 7 structure that creates a legally enforceable duty to operate in an environmentally and socially responsible manner, sustainable 8 9 business corporations frequently require less direct 10 intervention from state agencies and regulators than do 11 traditional corporate entities that operate according to the 12 sole duty of maximizing shareholder profit.

13 The legislature further finds that it is in the public 14 interest to raise awareness about this important type of 15 business structure and to preserve consumer confidence in these 16 entities. Currently, sustainable business corporations aren't 17 searchable in the State's business registration platform.



1 Additionally, there is currently no mechanism by which the State may terminate an entity's designation as a sustainable business 2 corporation for non-compliance with the requirements of state 3 4 statute or with corporate governance principles. 5 The purpose of this Act is to increase the visibility and 6 accountability of sustainable business corporations by: 7 (1)Requiring that sustainable business corporations file their annual benefit reports with the department of 8 9 commerce and consumer affairs; (2) Authorizing the department to terminate a designation 10 as a sustainable business corporation for 11 12 noncompliance with statutory requirements; and (3) Requiring the department to make sustainable business 13 corporation status a searchable element within its 14 public platform and to post a list of sustainable 15 business corporations registered to do business in the 16 17 State. SECTION 2. Chapter 420D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 18 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 19 designated and to read as follows: 20

16	status by	the department. (a) The department may terminate the
17	<u>status of</u>	a sustainable business corporation if the sustainable
18	business	corporation fails to comply with any provision of this
19	<u>chapter i</u>	n accordance with the notice, hearing, and procedural
20	requireme	ents of chapter 91.



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1	(b) The department shall issue a notice of intent to		
2	terminate the status of a sustainable business corporation prior		
3	to initiating procedures to terminate a status. The notice of		
4	intent shall afford the sustainable business corporation sixty		
5	days to remedy the noncompliance before any adverse action is		
6	taken pursuant to this section and chapter 91."		
7	SECTION 3. Section 420D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
8	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted		
9	and to read as follows:		
10	" "Department" means the department of commerce and consumer		
11	affairs."		
12	SECTION 4. The business registration division of the		
13	department of commerce and consumer affairs shall modify its		
14	online business registration platform such that registered		
15	entities are searchable and identifiable according to		
16	sustainable business corporation status. Further, the division		
17	shall maintain a list of all sustainable business corporations		
18	registered to do business in the State and shall indicate		
19	whether listed sustainable business corporations have achieved a		
20	B Corp Certification as issued by the nonprofit B Lab or similar		
21	third-party standard that complies with section 420D-12, Hawaii		



Revised Statutes. The division shall post on a separate webpage
from its searchable business registration platform:

- 3 (1) The list;
- Information explaining the governance structure of 4 (2) sustainable business corporations and how it differs 5 from that of other types of corporations; and 6 7 (3) The requirements and procedures for registering as a sustainable business corporation and remaining in 8 9 compliance with statutory and governance requirements. SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 11

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**Report Title:** Sustainable Business Corporations; DCCA

#### Description:

Requires sustainable business corporations to file annual benefit reports with DCCA. Authorizes DCCA to terminate sustainable business corporation status for noncompliance. Requires the Business Registration Division to post searchable information on sustainable business corporations on its website.

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
