

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE CAPITOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§6E- State capitol; environmental practices. (a) The
- 5 state capitol management committee shall develop and carry out a
- 6 plan by 2045 to establish the state capitol as a building that
- 7 conducts environmental practices to be a sustainable, resilient,
- 8 and energy-efficient building.
- 9 (b) The state capitol management committee shall adopt
- 10 environmental measures, including water reuse and energy
- 11 conservation, to carry out its plan.
- 12 (c) The department of accounting and general services
- 13 shall provide administrative support to the state capitol
- 14 management committee in developing and carrying out the plan
- 15 required pursuant to this section."
- 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
