A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide funding
3	for the operations of the office of the governor for the fiscal
4	biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.
5	SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the
6	context, as used in this Act:
7	"Expending agency" means the executive department,
8	independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other
9	establishment of the state government (other than the
10	legislature, office of Hawaiian affairs, and judiciary), the
11	political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public
12	institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which
13	is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this
14	Act.
15	Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
16	a house of representatives standing committee, shall mean the
17	following:

4	"Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which						
5	funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the						
6	programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriation						
7	are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used						
8	shall have the following meanings:						
9	A General funds						
10	"Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent						
11	and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a						
12	particular program during a specified period or periods, as						
13	denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent						
14	positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent						
15	positions.						
16	"Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific						
17	program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization						
18	responsible for carrying out the program followed by the						
19	organization number for the program.						

1 PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS

- 2 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much
- 3 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and
- 4 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or
- 5 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing
- 6 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal
- 7 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The
- 8 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal
- 9 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position
- 10 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided
- 11 elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law.

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1 PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE

- 2 SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application
- 3 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for
- 4 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
- 5 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
- 6 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 7 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 8 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the
- 9 extent possible.
- 10 SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
- 11 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
- 12 correct the errors.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
