

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DELAY IN PRIOR APPROVAL FOR MEDICAL SERVICES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Prior approval for medical services, also known
- 2 as precertification or preauthorization, refers to health
- 3 insurer requirements that certain physician-ordered treatments
- 4 or services must be approved in advance by the insurer or by a
- 5 medical review service contracted by the insurer before the
- 6 insurer will provide final reimbursement or payment. The
- 7 process of obtaining preauthorization for medical services may
- 8 hamper the ability of health care providers to provide the
- 9 necessary treatments to their patients and may also be one of
- 10 the factors in the shortage of doctors in the State.
- 11 The legislature finds that it is in the best interest of
- 12 the State to ensure that preauthorization requirements do not
- 13 negatively impact the health of Hawaii residents.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to exempt health care providers
- 15 from civil liability in the case of the provider's patient
- 16 receiving any injury or worsening of a health condition while
- 17 awaiting preauthorization for medical services or treatment.



## H.B. NO. 1463

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 671, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§671- Preauthorization; civil liability; exemption.
- 5 Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, a
- 6 licensed healthcare provider shall not be subject to any civil
- 7 liability for any injury to or for the exacerbation or worsening
- 8 of a health condition of a patient under the provider's care
- 9 while obtaining authorization from an insurer to provide medical
- 10 services or treatment for that patient."
- 11 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
