

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR PRESIDENT THEODORE ROOSEVELT HIGH SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, founded in 1930 and situated in Makiki on the island of Oahu, President Theodore

 Roosevelt high school has grown to serve an enrollment of more
- 4 than one thousand four hundred students. The school's existing
- 5 gymnasium and music building were constructed over fifty years
- 6 ago and do not meet current department of education standards.
- 7 The legislature provided funding for plans and design for a
- 8 master plan for a new gymnasium, new music building, and
- 9 additional on-site parking in Act 106, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 10 2012. The final master plan, DOE Job No. Q22000-13, dated
- 11 December 23, 2014, presented the preferred master plan for:
- 12 (1) A new gymnasium over a one-level parking structure at the site of the existing gymnasium; and
- (2) A new two-story music building and repurposing of theexisting music building.

8	SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue		
9	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$19,475,000 or so much		
10	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof		
11	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020		
12	for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects as		
13	follows:
