

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWENTY-THIRD HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that constructing a
- 2 "Manoa well-being center" at Manoa elementary school will
- 3 provide a facility to house a school garden and sustainability
- 4 program where students will develop a meaningful connection to
- 5 real food, healthier eating habits, and practical and real-world
- 6 project-based learning opportunities.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the facility will also
- 8 contain space to hold well-being classes for the surrounding
- 9 community, such as cooking nutrition training, urban gardening
- 10 lessons, and stress and lifestyle modification programs. The
- 11 facility will also continue to serve existing community needs
- 12 through the use of facilities for programs like scouting,
- 13 enrichment programs, and church groups.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for the
- 15 plans, design, construction, and equipment of a "Manoa well-
- 16 being center" at Manoa elementary school.
