## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 377-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) A full and complete record shall be kept of all
4	proceedings had before the board and all testimony and
5	proceedings shall be [ <del>taken down</del> ] recorded by a reporter engaged
6	for such purpose or by use of a mechanical recording device. It
7	shall not be necessary to transcribe the record unless requested
8	for purposes of rehearing or court review. In the proceedings
9	the board shall not be bound by technical rules of evidence.
10	[No hearsay evidence, however, shall be admitted or
11	considered.]"
12	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
