A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that developing a uniform
- 2 financial database for use by all state agencies would improve
- 3 government accountability and transparency, leverage existing
- 4 information technology systems, consolidate data from multiple
- 5 existing systems into a single system of record, and normalize
- 6 disparate account coding practices used by different state
- 7 agencies.
- 8 The legislature also finds that the department of education
- 9 has replaced its financial database with software that allows
- 10 the department to track capital improvement projects from
- 11 inception to completion, while integrating the project's
- 12 financial data. The software system captures and reports on
- 13 data regarding project budgets, appropriations, scheduling,
- 14 contractor documentation, contract changes, and payment
- 15 transactions. The legislature further finds that this software
- 16 system could be a major boon to other agencies, especially in

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- 1 the area of deferred maintenance projects, and should be adopted
- 2 by all state agencies.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to develop
- 4 and procure a uniform financial database, with parameters,
- 5 benefits, and features that are similar to the software system
- 6 being used by the department of education, for use by all state
- 7 agencies.
- 8 SECTION 2. The department of budget and finance, in
- 9 consultation with the department of accounting and general
- 10 services and the office of enterprise technology services, shall
- 11 develop and procure a uniform financial database, with
- 12 parameters, benefits, and features that are similar to the
- 13 software system being used by the department of education, for
- 14 use by all state agencies.
- 15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 18 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 19 2020-2021 for the development and procurement of a uniform
- 20 financial database for use by all state agencies.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
