A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii state

2 hospital in Kaneohe has been the long-term care facility

3 providing treatment for the State's forensic and non-forensic

4 mentally ill patients across the spectrum of acuteness. The

5 legislature also finds that the Hawaii state hospital has

6 reached capacity due to an overload of forensic patients, who

7 are individuals mandated by a criminal court to receive

8 treatment for mental illness. The Hawaii state hospital

9 currently has no capacity for non-forensic patients. Thus,

10 there is no option for non-forensic patients who need long-term

11 mental health treatment, many of whom suffer from a very high

degree of mental illness and are in critical need of long-term

13 professional care.

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14 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the

assessment, planning, and design of a long-term care facility

16 that admits and treats non-forensic mental health patients for

17 in-patient or out-patient temporary case management. As used in

- 1 this Act, "non-forensic mental health patients" shall not
- 2 include individuals receiving treatment for mental illness when
- 3 that treatment is mandated by a criminal court.
- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 8 2020-2021 for the assessment, planning, and design of a long-
- 9 term care facility that admits and treats non-forensic mental
- 10 health patients for in-patient or out-patient temporary case
- 11 management.
- 12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 13 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
