A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLE INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes,	is	
2	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§286- Vehicle inspector; certification; renev	<u>wal.</u> (a)	
5	The director shall supervise and certify all inspectors	e director shall supervise and certify all inspectors	
6	authorized to conduct vehicle inspections at official	inspection	
7	stations. The director shall:		
8	(1) Determine minimum standards and application of	criteria	
9	for inspectors;		
10	(2) Administer written and performance examination	ons for	
11	all applicants;

13	(4) Monitor inspection activities of inspectors;	and	
14	(5) Conduct investigations of reported or suspect	<u>ted</u>

1 Inspector certificates shall expire four years from the date of issuance, unless revoked or suspended by the 2 3 director. 4 (c) Recertification of inspectors shall follow the 5 application process for initial certification." 6 SECTION 2. Section 286-85, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 repealed. 8 ["\frac{9286-85}{Reconstructed vehicles, approval required. (a) 9 No person shall operate a reconstructed vehicle upon a public 10 highway unless it has been inspected and certified by the 11 designated county agency as meeting the specifications and 12 requirements established in rules and regulations adopted by the 13 state director of transportation. 14 (b) This section-shall not apply to any vehicle which is 15 subject to the rules and regulations of the public utilities 16 commission governing safety of operation and equipment. 17 (c) Each county through its chief executive officer, shall 18 designate a county department, whose responsibilities shall 19 include the inspection of reconstructed vehicles and the 20 issuance of permits to operate reconstructed vehicles pursuant

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1 to standards established by the state director of 2 transportation. 3 (d) The state director of transportation shall adopt rules 4 pursuant to chapter 91, establishing the fees an inspector may 5 charge for the inspection of a reconstructed vehicle. 6 (e) The department designated pursuant to subsection (c) 7 shall identify to the county director of finance every vehicle 8 that has been inspected and approved as a reconstructed vehicle. 9 (f) This section shall not apply to any privately owned 10 reconstructed vehicle in a county with a population of less than 11 500,000."] 12 SECTION 3. Section 286-42, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 14 The county finance director, upon being notified by the designated county department that a vehicle is a special 15 16 interest vehicle [or that a vehicle has been inspected and approved as a reconstructed vehicle], shall cause that fact to 17 18 be shown upon the registration and title certificates for that 19 vehicle."

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

DOT; Vehicle Safety Inspections; Inspectors; Reconstructed Vehicles; Special Inspection and Certification Requirement

Description:

Codifies certain certification, renewal, and violation processes of vehicle inspectors who conduct vehicle safety inspections under the DOT. Repeals section 286-85, HRS, which requires reconstructed vehicles to obtain a special inspection and certification. Takes effect on approval. (SD1)

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
