BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 329-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:

4 "(b) The designated state agency shall determine those 5 [schedules of controlled substances, classes of controlled 6 substances, and specific] controlled substances that are 7 purportedly being misused and abused in the State[-,] and 8 identify opioid antagonists that are used to reverse the effects 9 of opioid overdoses. As part of the controlled substance 10 registration process, all practitioners, except veterinarians, 11 and pharmacies shall be registered with the department to 12 utilize the electronic prescription accountability system. No 13 identified controlled substances or pharmacist-prescribed opioid 14 antagonists may be dispensed unless information relevant to the 15 dispensation of the substance or pharmacist-prescribed opioid 16 antagonist is reported electronically or by means indicated by 17 the designated state agency to the central repository
