- 9 <u>a government-issued identification by a live</u>
- 10 representative during each transaction;
- 11 (2) <u>Securely stores articles accepted by the kiosk for</u>
- 12 recycling;
- 13 (3) Captures and stores images of the seller and the
- 14 articles accepted during the transaction; and
- 15 (4) Reports electronically all transactions to law
- 16 <u>enforcement.</u>"

2. By amending the definition of "secondhand dealer" to
 read:

3 ""Secondhand dealer" means any person who trades in
4 secondhand or previously owned articles, <u>including the operation</u>
5 <u>of an automated recycling kiosk</u>, and includes any person subject
6 to part VII of chapter 445."

7 SECTION 2. Section 486M-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 "§486M-4 Minimum retention of items. (a) No dealer, the 10 dealer's agents, employees, or representatives shall alter, 11 melt, deface, break apart, dispose of, or change the character 12 or integrity of the precious or semiprecious metals or precious 13 or semiprecious gems received or purchased for a period of 14 fifteen calendar days in counties with a population of less than 15 [300,000,] three hundred thousand, and thirty calendar days in 16 counties with a population of [300,000] three hundred thousand 17 or more after the purchase or possession by the dealer, 18 whichever comes later. Every article received by the dealer, 19 the dealer's agents, employees, or representatives shall be 20 retained by the dealer in the county where received or purchased 21 for a period of fifteen calendar days in counties with a

1 population of less than [300,000,] three hundred thousand, and 2 thirty calendar days in counties with a population of [300,000]3 three hundred thousand or more after the purchase or possession 4 by the dealer, whichever comes later. 5 (b) At the discretion of the chief of police of each 6 county, the holding period may be reduced to fifteen calendar 7 days; provided that the dealer has computerized record-keeping 8 and transmittal capabilities acceptable to the chief of police

9 or the chief of police's authorized representative.

10 (c) This section shall not apply to a secondhand dealer
11 who only operates automated recycling kiosks."

12 SECTION 3. Section 486M-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended to read as follows:

14 "\$486M-5 Inspections. The chief of police of each county 15 or the chief of police's authorized representative may 16 immediately inspect, during normal business hours or whenever 17 the dealer or the dealer's agents or employees are otherwise 18 present, any records required by this chapter and any articles 19 described in [such] those records that the police reasonably 20 believe are stolen goods. A secondhand dealer who operates an

1	automated recycling kiosk shall provide to police upon request
2	and at no cost any articles that are received by the kiosk."
3	SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5	begun before its effective date.
6	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
