13		<pre>from fuel tanks;</pre>
14	(3)	Methods to improve communication between the United
15		States Navy, Air Force, and Army; the State; any local
16		board of water supply; and the public in the event of
17		a leak of any fuel tank;

1	(4) Groundwater test results in relation to the	
2	surrounding areas of fuel tank facilities, with a	
3	particular emphasis on the groundwater near the Red	
4	Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility;	
5	(5) The implications of shutting down any fuel tank	
6	facility; and	
7	(6) Updates on progress toward meeting goals of agreemen	nt
8	between the State, the affected county, and the	
9	federal government."
