A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL CANNABIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 329D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:

4	"(e) Retail dispensing locations shall not be open for

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1 dispensary shall only transport samples of cannabis and 2 manufactured cannabis products for laboratory testing for 3 purposes of this subsection in an amount and manner prescribed 4 by the department, in rules adopted pursuant to this chapter, 5 and with the understanding that state law and its protections do 6 not apply outside of the jurisdictional limits of the State." 7 SECTION 2. Section 329D-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 9 "(a) Medical cannabis production centers and dispensaries 10 shall comply with all county zoning ordinances, rules, or 11 regulations; provided that: 12 A medical cannabis production center shall be (1)13 permitted in any area in which agricultural production 14 is permitted except as provided within this chapter; 15 and 16 (2) No medical cannabis production center or dispensary 17 shall be permitted within seven hundred fifty feet of 18 the real property comprising a playground, public 19 housing project or complex, or school." 20 SECTION 3. Section 329D-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 21 repealed.

Medical Cannabis; Dispensaries; Dispensary Hours; Dispensary Location; Transportation; Sale or Transfer of License

Description:

Requires medical cannabis dispensaries to be closed on official state and federal holidays. Prohibits the transportation of cannabis to another county or island for testing except when there is no certified laboratory located in same county or island as the dispensary. Prohibits dispensaries from being located within 750 feet of a public housing project or complex. Repeals statute allowing for the sale or transfer of dispensary licenses.
