

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SEX TRAFFICKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§712-1202 Sex trafficking. (1) A person commits the
- 4 offense of sex trafficking if the person knowingly:
- 5 (a) Advances prostitution by compelling or inducing a
 6 person by force, threat, fraud, <u>coercion</u>, or
 7 intimidation to engage in prostitution, or profits
- from such conduct by another; or
 - (b) Advances or profits from prostitution of a minor; provided that with respect to the victim's age, the prosecution shall be required to prove only that the
- 12 person committing the offense acted negligently.
- 13 (2) Sex trafficking is a class A felony.
- 14 (3) As used in this section:
- 15 "Fraud" means making material false statements,
- 16 misstatements, or omissions.
