
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WILDLIFE OFFENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 183D-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Any person violating section [~~183D-66,~~] 183D-25.5,
4 183D-26, 183D-27, 183D-32, 183D-62, [~~or~~] 183D-64, or 183D-66
5 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof,
6 shall be punished as follows:

7 (1) For a first conviction by a mandatory fine of [~~not~~] no
8 less than \$200, or by imprisonment of [~~not~~] no more
9 than one year, or both[+] , and all animal parts,
10 products, or items containing prohibited animal parts
11 or products used in the commission of the violations
12 shall be considered contraband to be forfeited to and
13 disposed of by the State;

14 (2) For a second conviction within five years of a
15 previous conviction, by a mandatory fine of [~~not~~] no
16 less than \$1,000, or by imprisonment of [~~not~~] no more
17 than one year, or both, and all firearms, animal



1 parts, products, or items containing prohibited animal
 2 parts or products used in the commission of the
 3 violations shall be considered contraband to be
 4 forfeited to and disposed of by the State; and
 5 (3) For a third or subsequent conviction within five years
 6 of the first two or more convictions, by a mandatory
 7 fine of [~~not~~] no less than \$2,000, or by imprisonment
 8 of [~~not~~] no more than one year, or both, and all
 9 firearms, animal parts, products, or items containing
 10 prohibited animal parts or products used in the
 11 commission of the violations shall be considered
 12 contraband to be forfeited to and disposed of by the
 13 State."

14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
 16 begun before its effective date.

17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
