A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that properly installed
- 2 and maintained smoke alarms play a vital role in reducing fire
- 3 deaths and injuries. When there is a fire, smoke spreads fast
- 4 and working smoke alarms provide an early warning to allow those
- 5 present to escape quickly. Accordingly, the legislature finds
- 6 that smoke alarms are an essential part of home fire escape
- 7 plans.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require sellers of any
- 9 building or structure that is or can be occupied, in whole or in
- 10 part, for residential purposes to equip the building with
- 11 working smoke alarms in conformance with state or county
- 12 building or residential codes.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 132, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 15 and to read as follows:
- 16 "§132- Smoke alarms; residences. (a) Upon the sale or
- 17 transfer of any residential real property, the property shall be

- 1 equipped by the seller with smoke alarms that conform with all
- 2 applicable state and county building or residential codes.
- 3 For purposes of this section, "residential real property"
- 4 means real property upon which is situated a dwelling unit
- 5 comprising not more than four family units, the primary use of
- 6 which is occupancy as a home, including a condominium or
- 7 cooperative apartment.
- 8 (b) Each county fire department shall enforce this
- 9 section."
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
