A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF DEADLY FORCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the law
 relating to the use of deadly force to clarify that in certain
 circumstances, a person using deadly force has no duty to
 retreat and has the right to stand the person's ground.

5 SECTION 2. Section 703-304, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 "\$703-304 Use of force in self-protection. (1) Subject 8 to the provisions of this section and of section 703-308, the 9 use of force upon or toward another person is justifiable when 10 the actor believes that such force is immediately necessary for 11 the purpose of protecting [himself] the actor against the use of 12 unlawful force by the other person on the present occasion.

13 (2) The use of deadly force is justifiable under this 14 section if the actor believes that deadly force is necessary to 15 protect [himself] the actor against death, serious bodily 16 injury, kidnapping, rape, or forcible sodomy. <u>An actor who uses</u> 17 deadly force in accordance with this subsection does not have a
