BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 453, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designate	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§</u> 45	3- Advertising of specialty board certification.
5	(a) No pl	hysician licensed under this chapter shall hold oneself
6	out as ce	rtified by a specialty board or association in a
7	specialty	or subspecialty area of medicine unless the specialty
8	board or	association is a member board of one of the following
9	entities:	
10	(1)	American Board of Medical Specialties;
11	(2)	American Board of Physician Specialties;
12	(3)	American Osteopathic Association Bureau of Osteopathic
13		Specialists; or
14	(4)	Any other entity recognized by the Hawaii medical
15		board through rules adopted pursuant to chapter 91.
16	(b)	As used in this section:

1	"Specialty board or association" means a board or		
2	association which certifies physicians in a specialty or		
3	subspecialty area of medicine.		
4	"Specialty or subspecialty area of medicine" means a		
5	distinct and well-defined field of medical practice. It		
6	includes special concern with diagnostic and therapeutic		
7	modalities of patients' health problems, or it may concern		
8	health problems according to age, sex, organ system, body		
9	region, or the interaction between patients and their		
10	environment. A medical specialty promotes the standards of		
11	practice within its specialty association."		
12	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.		
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
