A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 444-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) This section shall not prohibit a specialty
- 4 contractor from taking and executing a contract involving the
- 5 use of two or more crafts or trades, if the performance of the
- 6 work in the crafts or trades, other than in which the specialty
- 7 contractor is licensed, is incidental and supplemental to the
- 8 performance of work in the craft for which the specialty
- 9 contractor is licensed[-]; provided that any new work under a C-
- 10 48 specialty license (structural steel contractor) or any
- 11 sublicense shall not be deemed to be incidental and supplemental
- 12 work."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.

Contractors; Specialty; Exemption

Description:

Requires a specialty contractor to obtain a C-48 specialty license (structural steel contractor) or sublicense if the performance of work on a contract requires a C-48 specialty license or sublicense and the specialty contractor does not have that specialty license or sublicense. Effective on 1/1/2050. (HD1)
