A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BICYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291C-145, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) Whenever a usable bicycle lane has been provided on a
4	highway, any person operating a bicycle [at a speed less than
5	the normal-speed of traffic moving in the same direction at such
6	time] shall ride within [such] <u>the</u> bicycle lane, except that
7	[such] <u>the</u> person may move out of the lane under any of the
8	following situations:
9	(1) When overtaking and passing another bicycle, vehicle,
10	or pedestrian within the lane or about to enter the
11	lane if [such] overtaking and passing cannot be done
12	safely within the lane;
13	(2) When preparing for a left turn at an intersection or
14	into a private road or driveway; or
15	(3) When reasonably necessary to leave the bicycle lane to
16	avoid debris or other hazardous conditions.

1	Any person in violation of this subsection shall be fined
2	not more than \$ per violation."
3	SECTION 2. Section 291C-148, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
5	"(b) Unless otherwise prohibited, a bicycle may be driven
6	at a speed of ten miles per hour or less on a sidewalk or
7	sidewalk area; provided that [the]:
8	(1) The driver of the bicycle shall yield the right-of-way
9	to any pedestrian [and that bicycle] <u>;</u>
10	(2) Bicycle riding shall be prohibited on sidewalks in
11	business districts [-]; and
12	(3) Whenever a usable bicycle lane is available, the
13	driver of the bicycle shall comply with section 291C-
14	<u>145(c).</u> "
15	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
16	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
17	begun before its effective date.
18	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
