A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION REBATE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State of Hawaii

2 has made significant progress in implementing policy to reduce

3 the use of fossil fuels for energy generation. However, more

4 than two-thirds of the fossil fuel imported into the State is

5 used for transportation, which is not included in Hawaii's one

6 hundred per cent renewable energy policy. Therefore, the

7 legislature finds that the State must accelerate a transition to

8 cleaner transportation to reach its carbon emissions reduction

9 goals.

10 Although the cost of electric vehicles has decreased and

continues to drop, the lack of electric vehicle charging systems

remains a barrier to the more widespread adoption of electric

13 vehicles. In 2019, the legislature enacted Act 142, Session

14 Laws of Hawaii 2019, which created a rebate program to

15 incentivize the build out of electric vehicle infrastructure to

16 make electric vehicles a viable option for more consumers.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate additional funds
- 2 to the electric vehicle charging system rebate program.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the energy
- 4 security special fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof
- 5 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to be deposited
- 6 into the public utilities commission special fund.
- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the public
- 8 utilities commission special fund the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 10 the electric vehicle charging system rebate program.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the public
- 12 utilities commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
