

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's high
- 2 school students and adult education students would benefit from
- 3 a work readiness preparation program. A close collaboration
- 4 between educators and industry employers would ensure that
- 5 students develop the skills and credentials needed to make them
- 6 highly employable.
- 7 The legislature recognizes the benefit of allowing
- 8 students, including students at adult and community schools, to
- 9 earn associate degrees, workforce development diplomas, pre-
- 10 apprenticeship certificates, and other industry-recognized
- 11 certificates.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish and
- 13 appropriate funds for a workforce readiness program.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to subpart C of part II to be
- 16 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 4 development and implementation of the workforce readiness
- 5 program.

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- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.

### Report Title:

DOE; Workforce Readiness Program; Establishment; Appropriation

#### Description:

Establishes within the Department of Education a Workforce Readiness Program to provide opportunities for students to earn associate degrees, workforce development diplomas, preapprenticeship certificates, and other industry-recognized certificates. Requires the department to designate schools, including adult community schools, to participate in the program. Appropriates funds.
