

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PIGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§183D- Wild or feral pigs; hunting regulations. (a)
- 5 It shall be lawful for any person with a valid hunting license
- 6 to take wild or feral pigs (Sus scrofa) on Mauna Kea with no bag
- 7 limitation and with dogs.
- 8 (b) For the purposes of this section, "Mauna Kea" means
- 9 all real property that is situated on the mountain on the island
- 10 of Hawaii known variously as Mauna Kea, Maunakea, Mauna a Wakea,
- 11 Mauna O Wakea, Ka Mauna a Kea, or Mauna Akea and held in trust
- 12 by the State and identified as government lands of Kaohe,
- 13 Hamakua District, Hawaii, tax map keys:
- <u>(1)</u> <u>(3)</u> <u>4-4-015:09;</u>
- (2) (3) 4-4-015:12; and
- 16 (3) That portion of (3) 4-4-015:01 serving as a road
- easement comprising 70.798 acres."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to
- 4 install one-way pig gates on the fencing surrounding the
- 5 watershed on Mauna Kea.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
