BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

11	(3)	Hypothenemus hampei, commonly known as "coffee borer
12		beetles" or "coffee berry borers";
13	(4)	Dynastinae, commonly known as "rhinoceros beetles";

15	(5)	Angiostrongylus cantonensis, commonly known as "rat
16		lungworm."

- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 2 funds for efforts to substantially reduce and eradicate the

- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 7 efforts to substantially reduce and eradicate invasive species
- 8 in the county of Maui.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2150.
