# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOBACCO.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 Smoking prohibited. (a) All public schools "§302A-102 4 within the State, from kindergarten through grade twelve, shall 5 prohibit the use of tobacco, including the smoking of tobacco 6 and use of chewing tobacco, at public schools or at public 7 school functions. 8 (b) Any person under the age of twenty-one who uses 9 tobacco at a public school or public school function shall be 10 required to attend a tobacco education course. 11 (c) As used in this section: 12 "Chewing tobacco" means any tobacco product exclusively 13 intended for the purpose of chewing. 14 "Tobacco education course" means a course approved by the department of health that integrates a best practices curriculum 15 16 to promote tobacco cessation."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general

- 6 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 9 begun before its effective date.
- 10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
