A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 264, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Flood zone; depth gauge signs. (a) 5 department of transportation or an appropriate county agency 6 shall post a depth gauge sign on any portion of a public highway 7 that: 8 (1) Is under its jurisdiction; 9 Lies within a special flood hazard area; and (2) **10** (3) Is prone to flooding. 11 The depth gauge sign shall be posted in a manner consistent with the manual on uniform traffic control devices. 12 13 (c) As used in this section: 14 "Depth gauge sign" means a depth gauge sign as defined by 15 the manual on uniform traffic control devices. 16 "Manual on uniform traffic control devices" means the most

- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
