BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 342G-117, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) The department shall evaluate the handling fee at
- 4 least once per year. Beginning on August 1, 2021, and every
- 5 August 1 thereafter, the handling fee shall be changed by the
- 6 percentage, if any, by which the Consumer Price Index for All
- 7 Urban Consumers in the Honolulu area published by the Bureau of
- 8 Labor Statistics of the federal Department of Labor for that
- 9 calendar year exceeds the Consumer Price Index for All Urban
- 10 Consumers for the prior calendar year; provided that, pursuant
- 11 to subsection (a), the handling fee shall be not less than the
- 12 prevailing deposit beverage container fee. If the department
- 13 changes the amount of the handling fee, the department shall
- 14 publish notice of the change within thirty days of its
- 15 determination."
