A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WAHIAWA DAM AND RESERVOIR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that climate change
- 2 is occurring, and it is a priority issue for the State. Climate
- 3 change poses immediate and long-term threats to Hawaii's
- 4 economy, sustainability, security, and way of life.
- 5 The legislature also recognizes that climate change creates
- 6 increased risks of both drought and sea level rise, making it
- 7 critical to maintain the State's water storage capabilities and
- 8 to protect downstream communities from flooding. To address
- 9 these risks, the Wahiawa dam and reservoir, which serves as a
- 10 major water supply for central and North Shore Oahu, must be
- 11 carefully monitored for safety and must be the subject of an
- 12 emergency intervention plan.
- 13 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to direct the
- 14 department of land and natural resources engineering division
- 15 dam safety program to develop an emergency intervention plan for
- 16 the Wahiawa dam and reservoir.

7	(1)	Communities that may need to evacuate in a dam
8		emergency, using inundation maps that highlight flood
9		areas and estimated travel times for floodwaters;
10	(2)	The dam owner's responsibilities to ensure timely and
11		effective action in the event of an emergency;
12	(3)	The respective responsibilities of the State and the
13		city and county of Honolulu and their areas of
14		jurisdiction in the event of a dam emergency;
15	(4)	Potential defects in the dam and reservoir;
16	(5)	Any aspects of the dam and reservoir that are not in
17		compliance with dam safety standards;
18	(6)	Financing opportunities to bring the dam into safety
19		compliance if necessary; and

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1	(7)	Opportunities for public outreach in the adjacent and	
2		downstream communities, for both the State and the dam	
3		owner.	
4	(c)	The department of land and natural resources	
5	engineeri	ng division dam safety program shall submit the Wahiawa	
6	dam and re	eservoir emergency intervention plan to the legislature	
7	no later	than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular	
8	session of 2022.		
9	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
10	revenues o	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so	
11	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for		
12	the Wahia	wa dam and reservoir emergency intervention plan. The	
13	moneys shall be allocated as follows:		
14	(1)	\$1,000,000 to develop the Wahiawa dam and reservoir	
15		emergency intervention plan;	
16	(2)	\$ to create one full-time equivalent (1.0	
17		FTE) permanent position in the department of land and	
18		natural resources engineering division dam safety	
19		program for a planner V to aid in the development of	
20		the Wahiawa dam and reservoir emergency intervention	

plan and to assist in carrying out dam inspection,

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	repair, and maintenance oversight pursuant to chapter
	179D, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
(3)	\$3,000,000 to purchase necessary dam safety emergency
	intervention equipment, which may include a dozer,
	excavator, tractor and flat-bed trailer, and other
	related dam supplies and materials which could include
	erosion control measures.
The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
land and	natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
